## **Heating**

The heating is controlled from the boiler in the kitchen and the thermostat in the hallway.

# Internet/Wi-Fi and mobile access

The Wi-Fi password is ANKLE-opt-bats, and the router can be found on the corner table in the sitting room.

Mobile phones do work in the area, but coverage does differ for different networks. O2 and Vodafone do have particularly poor signal.

# **Telephone**

There is a telephone in the property. The number is 01983 568 990. We operate a fair usage policy and if on receipt of the bill excessive calls have been made during your stay there will be a charge for this.

#### **Linen & Towels**

We do provide all linen and towels for your stay, and do ask that you do not take the towels to the beach.

#### **Rubbish Collections**

## **Important Information**

- There is parking for 2 cars outside the property.
- The fuse board is located in the high cupboard above the kitchen sink.
- The stopcock is in cupboard under the kitchen sink (second door along from the right, on the top right hand side).
- The gas meter is outside on the rear of the building to the left of the back door.
- The washing machine and dishwasher have individual shut off valves. Some basins, sinks and toilets have shut off valves others do not. The hot water tank is in the double bedroom at the top of the stairs and turn left. The cold water tank is in the roof space accessed by a trap upstairs, turn right and through the doorway.
- Fire Extinguishers can be found on the landing and in kitchen as well as a fire blanket.
- The switch to the light outside the front door is just inside the front door on the right.
- Outside seating cushions should be provided for you. If they are not there, please let me know. We do ask that you bring them inside at night if there is a forecast of rain.
